



Are you Rams enough?

Whether you're changing clubs, that cricket itch is back, or you're starting a blossoming career, there are always questions you have. This fact sheet has the most common FAQs & information you might want to know.



About the club:

Rams Cricket has a very proud history in the Hills district, with over 200 members in the 2017/18 season. When you play for Rams, you're not just a member, you're family. Rams Cricket run Woolworths Junior Blaster & Master Blaster programs for 8-10 yr olds learning to play cricket. We are invested in our community with the support of local businesses, & each year we have a Pink Stumps round, where our members don pink caps to raise funds, & support The McGrath Foundation.

What do you get for your registration fee? Fees go to getting you on the field, while all juniors receive a Rams training shirt, trophies for all juniors at the end of the season, & awards for outstanding achievements through all age groups. For those lucky enough to clinch a grand final victory with their mates, you will receive a traditional baggy cap acknowledging your achievement. Hang around for 5 yrs & you get a Rams playing cap with your unique member number, just like our Aussie cricketers.

Game Day:

Q. When?

A. Modified Cricket (U10s), Juniors (U10s-U16s) - Saturdays 8:30am to 12:30pm from mid Sept. to early Mar., with U11s-U16s playing finals until mid March., & a mid-season break from mid Dec. to the end of Feb.

A. Seniors - Saturdays 1:30pm to 6:15pm (1hr later in daylight savings) from mid Sept. to mid March., & a mid-season break from mid Dec. to the end of Jan.

A. Training is usually held on either a Wed or Thurs afternoon at one of our home grounds.

Q. Where?

A. Game venues range from Rouse Hill along the Windsor & Old Windsor Rd corridor down to Merrylands/Guildford area.



Q. Who?

A. Parents are encouraged to take on roles within their team to either coach, manage or assist those getting your kids on the field. It's a great way to spend time with your children & see them blossom & have fun!

A. 7-9 players per U10s team, 12 players per U11s, & U12s – 16s teams have 12 players per side.

A. Seniors - Teams are made up of full-time & part-time players, with reserves filling in from time to time.

Q. What?

A. You will need to provide white cricket pants, playing shirt & cap (purchase through the club) & shoes suitable for cricket (preferably light coloured). All other playing gear can be supplied by the club.

Q. Why?

A. The easier question to answer is why not? Have fun joking around & make lifelong friends & memories, take a wicket, grab a classic catch or hit those winning runs, we play because we love the game!!
